

## ORDINANCE NO. 149189

An Ordinance authorizing the transfer of \$975.00 from the Hydroelectric Power Construction Fund to the Electronic Services Operating Fund, increasing the appropriation of the Bureau of Electronic Services by \$975.00 for the purchase of a 2-way radio, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Hydroelectric Power requires a 2-way radio in order to maintain communications and coordination of activities in the field.
2. The Bureau of Hydroelectric Power has funds available in the 1979-80 Budget which may be allocated to this purchase.
3. A transfer of funds and increase in appropriation is necessary to allow purchase by the Bureau of Electronic Services for assignment to the Bureau of Hydroelectric Power.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Funds are transferred and appropriation increased as follows.
