### ORDINANCE NO. 149202

An Ordinance granting a Revocable Permit to C.R. Williams, deedholder, and CAM Industries, lessee, to expand the existing clothing manufacturing plant operation from 24 employees to 35 employees within the existing building in zone A2.5, located at 6115 N.E. Fremont, on Lots 7 through 11, Block 9, Burfield, under certain conditions, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. C.R. Williams, deedholder, and CAM Industries, lessee, have filed application for a Revocable Permit to expand the existing clothing manufacturing plant operation from 24 to 35 employees within the existing building, in zone A2.5, located at 6115 N.E. Fremont.
- The legal description of said property is Lots 7 through 11, Block 9, Burfield.
- 3. Applicants have paid the proper fee for the filing of such an application.
- 4. A duly authorized and conducted public hearing has been held by the City's Hearings Officer on February 4, 1980 (Planning Commission File No. 6925R) and the Hearings Officer recommends that a Revocable Permit to expand the existing clothing manufacturing plant operation from 24 employees to 35 employees within the existing building be allowed, under certain conditions.
- 5. The City Auditor has complied with the notice requirements of the ordinance for the hearing before the Hearings Officer.

- b. This Revocable Permit is granted under the following conditions:
  - Applicants shall sign a street waiver for improvement of N.E. Milton Street satisfactory to the City Engineer.
  - The applicants shall contact and work with the Transportation Planning Section of the Bureau of Planning and the Business Assistance Representative of Tri-Met to establish a carpool and vanpool program.

- 3) A Building Permit or an Occupancy Permit must be obtained from the Bureau of Buildings, Room 111, City Hall, 1220 S.W. 5th Avenue, 248-4241, before carrying out this project in order to assure that all conditions imposed here and all requirements of the pertinent Building Codes are met.
- 4) The Revocable Permit hereby granted is personal to the permittees and may not be transferred, assigned or otherwise disposed of by said permittees.
- 5) The Revocable Permit hereby granted shall be revocable at the pleasure of the City Council and no expenditures of money hereunder or lapse of time or any act or thing shall operate as an estoppel against the City of Portland, or be held to give the permittees any vested or other right.
- 6) Permittees shall comply with the provisions of the Code of the City of Portland, and all other applicable ordinances, provisions and regulations of the City, whether presently existing or hereafter enacted.
- c. Neither this ordinance nor any permit issued hereunder shall be effective until accepted, filed and recorded in accordance with law.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because there should be no delay in the beneficial use of the above-described property; therefore this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
