

# ORDINANCE No. 149218

An Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent to call for bids for the construction of a reinforced concrete pressure reducing valve vault to house the 48" diameter pressure reducing valve for the Bureau of Hydroelectric Power, authorizing a contract, authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. That it is necessary to construct a reinforced concrete valve vault to house the 48" pressure reducing valve to be installed as part of the Hydroelectric facilities to be built at Dam #2 in the Bull Run watershed.
2. That delay in bidding on the valve vault construction will result in delay of the Project and resulting increased costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Purchasing Agent shall advertise for bids using specifications filed in his office on February 15, 1980 and in the event that no satisfactory bid is received, shall readvertise on the same basic specifications until a satisfactory bid is received.
- b. A contract is authorized with the most favorable bidder as designated by the Council.
- c. The Mayor and the Auditor hereby are authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the 1979-1980 Budget, Bureau of Hydroelectric Power, BUC #64200003, Object Code 630, when demand is presented, approved by the proper authorities.


Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with the construction may result in additional expense, and will unnecessarily deprive the City of the benefits of completion of the contract at an early date; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
