PURCHASE AGREEMENT CONTRACT

THIS AGREEMENT is by and between the OREGON STATE MARINE BOARD, hereinafter called the Board, and the CITY OF PORTLAND, hereinafter called the City.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this agreement is to provide funding, whole or in part, for the purchase and equipping of one (1) Marine Safety Patrol Boat subject to the conditions as specified in the Marine Safety and Law Enforcement Agreement entered into jointly by the City of Portland, Port of Portland, and County of Multnomah, dated February 8, 1980.

PROVISIONS

The Board does hereby agree to provide up to \$23,700.00 for the purchase and equipping, whole or in part, of one (1) patrol boat as mutually agreed by the three signators of the previously mentioned Marine Safety and Law Enforcement Agreement and the Board.

The Board further agrees to provide payment to the City within thirty (30) days of receipt of billing, provided such billing is accompanied by an acceptable invoice of costs of the boat and all related items purchased.

In conformance with the above cited tri-party agreement, ownership and possession of the patrol boat to be purchased with these funds are to be transferred to the County of Multinomah upon termination of the operating agreement.

ORDINANCE No. 149236

An Ordinance authorizing a purchase agreement contract with the Oregon State Marine Board to provide funding by the State Marine Board of up to \$23,700 for the purchase and equipping of a marine patrol boat, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- (1) That the Oregon State Marine Board has agreed to provide up to \$23,700 to the city for the purchase and equipping of one (1) patrol boat;
- (2) That the city has heretofore entered into an agreement with Multnomah County and the Port of Portland to provide for law enforcement services to be provided by Multnomah County personnel and to provide for a cost allocation of the patrol and maintenance services;
- (3) That in order to provide the funding from the Oregon State Marine Board it is necessary that an agreement be entered into, which agreement would provide services in accordance with the former agreement between the city, Multnomah County and the Port of Portland;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

(a) That the mayor is hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the city a purchase agreement contract with the Oregon State Marine Board to provide for funding to the city from the Marine Board of up to \$23,700 for the purchase and equipping of one (1) patrol boat to be used for law enforcement purposes in accordance with the agreement between the city and the Port of Portland and Multnomah County. The form of agreenent shall be in accordance with the form of agreement attached to this ordinance.

Section 2. The Council declares:

In order that the funding from the Oregon State Marine Board for the purchase and equipping of a patrol boat to be used for law enforcement purposes may be authorized without unnecessary delay; therefore, an emergency exists and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
