

ORDINANCE NO. 149210

An Ordinance transferring \$6,439 within the Housing and Community Development and \$12,589 within the Sewage Disposal Fund for sewer service to the Union Labor Retirement Association elderly housing project at SE 84th Avenue and Powell Blvd., and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. That Ordinance #148210, passed August 1, 1979, approved transfer of appropriations from the Housing and Community Development Fund for extension of water and sewer service to the Union Labor Retirement Association elderly housing project at SE 84th and Powell Blvd.
2. That the above mentioned ordinance transferred \$53,150 to the Sewage Disposal Fund for the sewer extension portion of the project.
3. That \$47,000 of the \$53,150 was transferred to the Bureau of Sanitary Engineering with the balance of \$6,150 held in the Sewage Disposal Fund.
4. That bids were obtained for the sewer extension through the normal bidding procedure.
5. That the lowest responsible bid was \$59,589, \$12,589 higher than the estimated amount of \$47,000.
6. That \$12,589 should be transferred to the Bureau of Sanitary Engineering to cover the higher than estimated costs from the following sources: \$6,439 from the Housing and Community Development Fund and \$6,150 from the Sewage Disposal Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The 1979-80 City Budget is amended as follows:

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the appropriation is needed immediately in the account to which it is to be transferred, so that there may be no delay in providing sewer service to the Union Labor Retirement Association elderly housing project; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by Council.




