

# ORDINANCE No. 149250

An Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Manager to call for bids to furnish materials, equipment and labor, and for constructing the N. Lombard Street Wastewater Pumping Station, for the Bureau of Sanitary Engineering, authorizing a contract, authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Sanitary Engineering requires the furnishing of materials, equipment and labor, and the construction of the N. Lombard Street Wastewater Pumping Station, in accordance with the plans and specifications filed with the Purchasing Division.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Purchasing Manager shall advertise for bids using plans and specifications filed in his office on February 29, 1980.
- b. That a contract be authorized with the most favorable bidder as recommended by the City Engineer and designated by the Council.
- c. That the Mayor and the Auditor are authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewage Disposal Fund, FY 1979-80 Budget, Bureau of Sanitary Engineering, Design Engineering Division, RU 146, Object Code No. 630, Improvements, when demand is presented and approved by proper authority.


Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in starting construction could cause the City to lose EDA and Port of Portland funds for the subject project; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
