# ORDINANCE No. 149274

An Ordinance transferring \$25,000 within the 1979-80 City budget for the Bureau of Planning for partitions, furniture and equipment associated with the Bureau's relocation to new office space, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Planning is required to relocate its offices in April, 1980.
- The Bureau's new office will require movable partitions as part of the space arrangements;
- 3. The Bureau's new office will provide additional conference and meeting space, requiring certain additional items of furniture and equipment;
- 4. Certain built-in cabinets, bookcases and equipment now used by the Bureau cannot be moved to their new office, requiring that these items be replaced with movable objects;
- 5. Sufficient funds are available for the necessary partitions, furniture and equipment in the Bureau's current 1979-80 appropriations for Materials & Services;
- 6. The 1979-80 City budget for the Bureau of Planning should be amended by transferring funds from Materials & Services to Capital Outlay.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs,

a. The 1979-80 City budget for the Bureau of Planning is amended as follows:

### GENERAL FUND

From: Bureau of Planning, Object 210 \$25,000

To: Bureau of Planning, Object 640 \$25,000

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because partitions, furniture and equipment for the Bureau of Planning must be ordered without delay; and that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
