### ORDINANCE NO. 149298

An Ordinance transferring \$1,755 within the General Fund from the Metropolitan Human Relations Commission Personal Services, to Metropolitan Human Relations Commission Capital Outlay, for the purchase of an Olivetti ET 221 Electronic Typewriter, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

### Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Metropolitan Human Relations Commission requires \$1,755 transferred from Personal Services to Capital Outlay for the purchase of a typewriter.
- 2. MHRC's electric typewriter is eleven years old and has had to be repaired several times in the last few months. The MHRC now faces a situation where it is no longer cost-efficient to maintain the IBM typewriter.
- 3. Due to the nature of MHRC's responsibilities, the electronic typewriter will increase productivity considerably. MHRC estimates that 40% of its typing is statistical in nature, and the many automatic features of the electronic typewriter will allow greater efficiency, especially as related to detailed statistical typing.

### NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. \$1,755 is transferred within the General Fund from MHRC, Personal Services 120, to Metropolitan Human Relations Commission (341), Capital Outlay 640.
