ORDINANCE No. 149306

An Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Manager to call for bids to furnish materials, equipment and labor, and for constructing the Elk Rock Wastewater Pumping Station, for the Bureau of Sanitary Engineering, authorizing a contract, authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- The Bureau of Sanitary Engineering requires the furnishing of materials, equipment and labor, and the construction of the Elk Rock Wastewater Pumping Station, in accordance with the plans and specifications filed with the Purchasing Division.
- 2. That FY 80 Environmental Protection Agency funds are not available for this project.
- 3. That the Council decided during approval of the FY 79-80 Budget that this project should be totally funded by Sewage Disposal Funds if EPA funds were unavailable.
- 4. That funds for this project are available in the Bureau of Sanitary Engineering, Design Engineering Division, FY 79-80 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Purchasing Manager shall advertise for bids using plans and specifications filed in his office.
- b. That a contract be authorized with the most favorable bidder as recommended by the City Engineer and designated by the Council.
- c. That the Mayor and the Auditor are authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewage Disposal Fund, FY 1979-80 Budget, Bureau of Sanitary Engineering, Design Engineering Division, RU 146, Object Code 630, Improvements, when demand is presented and approved by proper authority.
- Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in starting construction could cause additional pollution

of the Willamette River in the area of the elevated Willamette Interceptor sewer line; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect form and after its passage by the Council.
