ORDINANCE NO. 149308

An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Auditor to execute and deliver to Union Pacific Railroad Company an Extension Rider extending the City's lease of railroad property in the vicinity of the Columbia Blvd. Wastewater Treatment Plant for a period of one year, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- That by authority of Ordinance No. 147913, the City entered into a lease agreement with Oregon-Washington Railroad & Navigation Company and its lessee, Union Pacific Railroad Company, to provide a location for temporary storage of fill material during dike construction for the sludge lagoon near the Columbia Blvd. Wastewater Treatment Plant, said lease to expire on April 30, 1980.
- 2. That it appears the construction work now under contract will not be completed on the schedule originally anticipated, and it is necessary that the lease be extended for a period of one year; the new expiration date to be April 30, 1981.
- 3. That the railroad is willing to extend the lease, and such extension should now be authorized.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and Auditor are authorized to sign an Extension Rider, approved as to form by the City Attorney, extending the term of the lease of Union Pacific Railroad Company property to April 30, 1981, said lease having been originally authorized by Ordinance No. 147913. Said Extension Rider shall be substantially in accordance with Exhibit "A" attached to the original only of this Ordinance, and by this reference made a part thereof.
- b. The Auditor shall forward the signed Extension Rider to Union Pacific Railroad Company, Real Estate Department, Room 600, Pittock Block, PO Box 4265, Portland, Oregon 97208, Attention: Mr. Chas. K. Landskroner, District Real Estate Director, for signatures of the railroad company.
- c. That upon receipt by the Auditor of the fully executed Extension Rider, the document shall be filed in the appropriate City records.
