

## Resolution No. 22495 - 2

WHEREAS, in the matter of establishing a street as herein shown and which will constitute N.W. 26th Avenue between N.W. Yeon Avenue and N.W. Front Avenue, in the City of Portland, Oregon, pursuant to Resolution No. 22385 only \$1.00 was allowed as damages in favor of each of the owners of property embraced within this proposed street area by reason of the fact that the area has been used for many years as for street purposes although no official record of dedication appears, and the Council by Ordinance No. 80545 has transferred and made available in the city treasury the amount of damages allowed to the owner or owners of each of the parcels designated as appropriated for said street and authorized a warrant to be drawn in favor of each of such owners therefor, and the property required for said street should now be declared to have been condemned and obtained and such condemnation made a matter of record, and

WHEREAS, from an examination of the plat filed with and made a part of the City Engineer's report a clerical error appears in giving the distance from N.W. Yeon Avenue to the southwesterly line of the Northern Pacific Railway Company's right of way as 601.01 feet along the easterly side of said avenue, whereas the true distance is 611.81 feet, and on the westerly side of said avenue the distance is 629.62 feet in place of 619.42 feet as given on said plat, and the distance across said right of way along each of said lines is 61.22 feet in place of 71.42 feet; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED that N.W. 26th Avenue between N.W. Yeon Avenue and N.W. Front Avenue, in the City of Portland, Oregon, be and the same is hereby declared to be opened, laid out and established as a city street, 60 feet in width, as provided by Ordinance No. 80285 adopting the report of the City Engineer and said map is hereby deemed amended and corrected as above stated, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Engineer be and he is hereby instructed to record with the County Clerk of Multnomah County within 90 days after the

adoption of this resolution a copy of this resolution  
and a map corrected as above provided of said street  
extension.
