CITY OF PORTLAND RENEWABLE FUELS STANDARD ADVISORY

RE: Portland City Code Chapter (PCC)16.60.030 A—Exemptions

As provided under PCC Chapter 16.60.030 A, a fuel retailer who sells B20 (biodiesel blend of 20% biodiesel) or greater at one or more standard, fixed pumps, at the fuel retailer's location, may also offer for sale #2 diesel on the same contiguous location.

It has been brought to our attention that several non-retail dealers as defined by Portland City Code Chapter 16.60 have interpreted the above-referenced exemption to apply to their cardlock operations. The code is clear that the exemption applies only to retail dealers.

In order for any particular non-retail dealer's location to qualify for the exemption in PCC 16.60.030.A, B20 fuel must be offered for retail sale to the general public.. For example, the B20 fuel pump must allow fuel purchase by the general public using any consumer debit or credit card on any site where they are pursuing this exemption.
