The two most recent violations, which occurred on April 23, and April 22, respectively are visible in the attached screenshot.

I respectfully request that the Auditor investigate each of these violation of the timely disclosure provisions of 2.10.030 and take all appropriate enforcement actions in accordance with PCC 2.10.050.

The version of the webpage available at <u>https://tedwheeler.com/</u> (screenshot as of 4/24/2020 attached) is a Communication subject to PCC 2.10.030, however it fails to Prominently Disclose the required funding information.

Specifically, for a website, text is not Prominently Disclosed unless it is displayed "in type of a **contrasting color** in the **same or larger font size** as used for the majority of text in the message." (emphasis added)

### Contrast

Although "contrasting color" is not specifically defined in the Code, the Web Contrast Accessibility Guidelines ("WCAG") (https://www.w3.org/TR/WCAG20/) are instructive. (see, also https://webaim.org/articles/contrast/).

Contrast is a measure of the difference in color between two elements in an image, and relates to readability. The background text at the bottom of the webpage is a lilac color specified by hexadecimal code #94A7C4. The text of the disclaimer is white (#FFFFF).

Using the tool at <u>https://monsido.com/tools/contrast-checker</u> shows that the Communication displays the required text at a contrast ratio of 2.45/1 and further shows that the text fails to meet any of the various accessibility standards including WCAG.

A second tool at <u>https://wave.webaim.org/report#/www.tedwheeler.com</u> shows the same result. It specifically flags the required text as having "Very Low Contrast."

It is also relevant that the text in the footer with the required language has the lowest contrast of any of the text on that page.

### Font Size

While there is very little text on the Webpage, all of the content is at larger fonts than the required language.
