ORDINANCE No. 149333

An Ordinance authorizing a contract with Diesel Service Unit Co. pursuant to Bid No. 92, opened March 4, 1980, for three $1\frac{1}{2}$ Yard Dump Trucks for the sum of \$28,197.00 for the Bureau of Fleet Management, authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants, waiving performance bond and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Purchasing Agent has advertised and received proposals for furnishing three $1\frac{1}{2}$ Yard Dump Trucks for the Bureau of Fleet Management for assignment to the Maintenance Bureau, said bids being opened March 4, 1980.
- 2. Diesel Service Unit Co. submitted a bid in the amount of \$28,197.00 and was the lowest acceptable bidder.
 - 3. The Manager of the Bureau of Fleet Management recommends and the Commissioner of Public Utilities concurs, that a contract should be awarded to Diesel Service Unit Co.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Commissioner of Public Utilities hereby are authorized to enter into a contract with Diesel Service Unit Co. 4810 N. Basin, Portland, Oregon, for furnishing three 1½ Yard Dump Trucks for the total sum of \$28,197.00, said contract shall be approved as to form by the City Attorney and a performance bond requirement from the contractor hereby is waived.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor hereby are authorized to draw and deliver to Diesel Service Unit Co., 4810 N. Basin, Portland, Oregon, a warrant or warrants chargeable to the 1979-80 Budget, Equipment (56200037/643), when demand is presented, approved by the proper authorities.
- Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with this purchase may result in additional expenses to the City and will unnecessarily deprive the Maintenance Bureau of the benefits of completion of the contract at an early date; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
