

ORDINANCE NO. 1493-11

An Ordinance creating one position of Engineering Technician and abolishing one position of Drafting Specialist in the Bureau of Sanitary Engineering, Wastewater Management Division, establishing rates of pay, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The reclassification of one position of Drafting Specialist to Engineering Technician has been approved by the Civil Service Board at its meeting of 2/19/80.
- 2. This reclassification is necessary to more accurately reflect the work responsibility.
- 3. No additional appropriation is needed in the Bureau's FY 1979-80 budget, as the entry rate for Engineering Technician does not exceed the budgeted salary for Drafting Specialist.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The following position is created in the Bureau of Sanitary Engineering, with salary rates in accordance with the current Compensation Plan.




