An ordinance declaring the cost of improving SW 47th Avenue from the southerly line of SW Seymour Court to the centerline of SW Hamilton St.; SW Seymour Ct. from the westerly line of SW 47th to the westerly line of SW 50th Avenue; SW 48th Avenue from the north line of SW Seymour Ct. to the centerline of SW Hamilton Street and construct storm sewers,

and assessing the property benefited thereby, declaring such assessment and directing the entry of the same in the Docket of City Liens.

THE CITY OF PORTLAND ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the Council has considered the proposed assessment for improving SW 47th Avenue from the southerly line of SW Seymour Court to the centerline of SW Hamilton St.; SW Seymour Ct. from the westerly line of SW 47th to the westerly line of SW 50th Avenue; SW 48th Avenue from the north line of SW Seymour Ct. to the centerline of SW Hamilton Street and construct storm sewers,

and all objections made thereto, and hereby ascertains, determines and declares the whole cost of said improvement in the manner provided by Ordinance No. <u>147512</u> to be the sum of $\frac{153,581.44}{1000}$ and that the special and peculiar benefits accruing to each lot, or part thereof or parcel of land within the assessment district, by reason of said improvement and in just proportion to such benefits, are in the respective amounts set opposite the number or description of each lot, or part thereof, or parcel of land in the annexed assessment roll, and said assessment roll is hereby adopted and approved as the assessment for said improvement, and the Auditor of the City of Portland is directed to enter a statement of the assessment hereby made in the Docket of City Liens, and cause notice thereof to be published as provided by the Charter and the Code of the City of Portland.
