

ORDINANCE NO. 149359

An Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent to call for bids to construct an Anchored Wire Mesh Blanket to control rockfall above the access road to Dam No. 1 for the Bureau of Hydroelectric Power, at the estimated cost of \$58,020.00, transferring funds, authorizing a contract, authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. That it is necessary to build an anchored wire mesh blanket to control rockfall above the access road to Dam No. 1.
2. The estimated cost to complete this work is \$58,020.00.
3. That a transfer of funds from Contingency is necessary to do this work.
4. That delay in bidding on the construction of an anchored wire mesh blanket to control rockfall above the access road to Dam No. 1 will impact the construction schedule of other critical projects including the hydroelectric powerplant at Dam No. 1.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Purchasing Agent shall advertise for bids using specifications filed in his office and in the event that no satisfactory bid is received, shall readvertise on the same basic specifications until a satisfactory bid is received.
- b. That a transfer of funds in the amount of \$58,020.00 from the Hydro-power Fund Contingency, BUC #64000012, Object Code 710 to the Hydro-power Construction Fund, BUC #64200003, Object Code 630 (Improvements) is authorized.
- c. A contract is authorized with the most favorable bidder as designated by the Council.
- d. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the 1979-80 Budget, Bureau of Hydroelectric Power, BUC #64200003, Object Code 630, when demand is presented, approved by the proper authorities.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with the construction may result in additional expense, and will unnecessarily deprive the City of the benefits of completion

of the contract at an early date; therefore, the Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
