

ORDINANCE No. 149370

An Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent to call for bids to construct the Clatsop Pump Station for the Bureau of Water Works, authorizing a contract, authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Water Works requires a pump station on S.E. Clatsop Street to supply water at adequate pressure to customers in the vicinity of the Clatsop Reservoir.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:


- a. The Purchasing Agent shall advertise for bids using Specifications filed in his office on March 24, 1980 and in the event that no satisfactory bid is received, shall readvertise the same basic Specifications until a satisfactory bid is received.
- b. A contract is authorized with the most favorable bidder as designated by the Council.
- c. The Mayor and the Auditor hereby are authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the 1979-80 Budget, Bureau of Water Works, Water Fund, BUC 18600374, Object Code 630, Project No. 3731, when demand is presented, approved by the proper authorities.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with the construction may result in additional expense, and will unnecessarily deprive the City of the benefits of completion of the contract at an early date; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
