Comprehensive Options for Drug Abusers, Inc., Contractor.

The parties have previously executed a contract providing for the creation and funding of a number of positions for public service employment, which contract is known as Contract No. 18236. That contract should now be amended to increase salaries of two positions effective January 1, 1980; increase the fringe benefit amount, and increase the contract amount by \$1,317.

The parties to the contract therefore agree:

a) The participant salaries are increased as follows:



Comprehensive Options for Drug Abusers, Inc., Contractor.

The parties have previously executed a contract providing for the creation and funding of a number of positions for public service employment, which contract is known as Contract No. 18237. That contract should now be amended to increase salaries of three positions effective January 1, 1980; increase the fringe benefit amount and increase the contract amount by \$1,976.

The parties to the contract therefore agree:





ORDINANCE NO. 149377

An Ordinance authorizing amendments to four Public Service Employment contracts under Title II-D of CETA with the Training and Employment Division of the Human Resources Bureau, increasing participant salary rates, increasing fringe benefit amounts, increasing contract amounts, transferring appropriations within the CETA Fund in the amount of \$4,678, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Pursuant to Ordinance No. 148560, the City of Portland authorized fifty-three Public Service Employment Contracts under the Human Resources Bureau to be funded under Title II-D of CETA.
2. Among these contracts were Contract Nos. 18236 and 18237 with the Comprehensive Options for Drug Abusers, Inc. (CODA) and Contract Nos. 18263 and 18264 with St. Johns Child Care, Inc.
3. These contracts should now be amended to increase the salary rates for participants in order to provide parity with non-CETA employees, as required by CETA Regulations.
4. Sufficient funds to cover the cost of these amendments are available under Title II-D of CETA from the Department of Labor.
5. It is therefore appropriate that the Mayor and Commissioner of Public Utilities execute, on behalf of the City, amendments to these contracts as set forth in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Mayor and Commissioner of Public Utilities execute, on behalf of the City, amendments to Contracts No. 18236, 18237, 18363 and 18264, as set forth in Exhibit "A".


