ORDINANCE NO. **1493**79

An Ordinance transferring \$2,500 from the Office of General Services budget to the Parking Facilities Fund, and increasing the appropriation of the Parking Facilities Fund by \$5,000 for the purpose of undertaking a feasibility study for adding additional parking floors to the Portland Auto Port at a cost of \$7,500, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

- 1. The FY 1979-80 budget of the Office of General Services contains an appropriation of \$2,500 for undertaking a feasibility study for adding additional parking floors to the Portland Auto Port.
- 2. It is anticipated that when the City-County Justice Center is built that the Police Bureau will need to house its vehicles in the Auto Port Garage, which would reduce the number of commercial spaces available in the garage.
- 3. Rather than reduce the general public's use of the garage, we would like to undertake a feasibility study to see if additional parking floors could be added to the Portland Auto Port Parking Garage.
- 4. The feasibility study would determine the utility of expanding the garage, the maximum vertical expansion capabilities of the structure's various systems, and cost estimates and appraisal of construction needs on existing parking operations.
- 5. The original appropriation does not allow for as complete a feasibility study as envisioned nor needed, thus the increased appropriation which will come directly from the parking garage revenues.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The following fund transfer and appropriation increase be made:
