# ORDINANCE NO. **149381**

An Ordinance transferring \$111,950 within the Sewage Disposal Fund to allow the purchase of seven hydraulically equipped utility trucks by the Bureau of Fleet Management for assignment to the Bureau of Maintenance, Sewer Repair Division to increase productivity of the sewer repair crews, transferring \$46,950 within the General Fund, increasing the Fleet Operating Fund \$65,000 and declaring an emergency.

## The City of Portland Ordains:

### Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The purchase of hydraulically equipped utility trucks to assist sewer repair crews will increase crew efficiency and produce a first year savings of \$119,783, and \$80,583/yr on-going.
- 2. There are seven sewer repair crews requiring hydraulically equipped utility trucks and tools estimated to cost \$21,025 each for a total of \$147,175.
- 3. That the Sewage Disposal Fund should provide funds not available for the purchase of the equipment through the Bureau of Fleet Management and tools through the Bureau of Maintenance.
- 4. That the utilization of personnel savings has been addressed in the requested 1980-81 Maintenance Bureau Budget.

### NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The 1979-80 City budget is hereby amended to change appropriations as follows:
