

ORDINANCE NO. 149386

An Ordinance transferring \$1,500 within the General Fund from General Operating Contingency to the Bureau of Street and Structural Engineering for the purchase and installation of bicycle parking racks on the lower level of the Pioneer Square parking garage, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bicycle and Pedestrian Program in the Bureau of Street and Structural Engineering requires \$1,500 to purchase and install additional bicycle parking racks in the Pioneer Square parking garage.
2. Additional bicycle parking is desirable in this location because the existing rack is inadequate to meet demand during good weather. Bicycle parking in this location is popular because the racks are protected from the weather, the high volume of foot traffic on Sixth Avenue deters theft, and the central location serves the needs of both commuters and shoppers.
3. On February 27, 1980, Council approved an interim use plan for the Pioneer Square parking garage that provides space for increased bicycle parking after closure of the lower level.
4. The Citizen's Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee has endorsed the installation of bicycle parking racks in this location and has recommended the types of racks to be purchased.
5. The Portland Development Commission has approved a plan for location of the racks.
6. This expenditure will be funded by 1% gas tax revenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That \$1,500 be transferred within the General Fund from the General Operating Contingency to the Bureau of Street and Structural Engineering (15900351/3379.640) for purchase and installation of additional bicycle parking racks.

ORDINANCE No.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because the transfer and appropriation are needed for the bicycle parking racks to be installed before summer of 1980; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage by the Council.
