

## ORDINANCE No. 149392

An Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent to call for bids for redevelopment of Glenwood Park as part of a grant from the Department of the Interior, authorizing a contract, authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Parks requires redevelopment of Glenwood Park as part of their Urban Demonstration Grant from the Heritage Conservation and Recreation Service entitled, "Portland Neighborhood Parks", Project No. 41-01013 (OP 1449).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Purchasing Agent shall advertise for bids using plans and specifications prepared by the firm of Mitchell, Nelson and Walsh, Incorporated, and filed in the Purchasing Agent's office by the Bureau of Parks. In the event no satisfactory bid is received, the Purchasing Agent shall readvertise on the same specifications until a satisfactory bid is received.
- b. A contract is authorized with the most favorable bidder as designated by the Council.
- c. The Mayor and the Auditor hereby are authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the 1979-80 Budget; General Fund, Bureau of Parks, RU 139, when demand is presented approved by the proper authorities.


