

ANNEXATION

CITY OF PORTLAND

"Property located in the NE 1/4 Section 22,
Township 1 South, Range 2 East of the W.M.,
Multnomah County, Oregon, more particularly
described as follows:"

Beginning at the northwest Corner of Lot 1, Brookside; thence South along the west line of said Lot 1 and its extension to the center line of Brookside Drive; thence easterly along said center line 101 feet, more or less, to its intersection with the east line extended south, of said Lot 1; thence north along said extension and east lot line 261.14 feet, more or less, to the northeast corner of said Lot 1; thence west 100.4 feet to the point of beginning.

Annexation

CITY OF PORTLAND

Beginning at the northeast corner of Lot 12, Brookside, being also a point in the center line of Johnson Creek; thence south along the east line of said Lot 12 and its extension to the center line of SE Brookside Drive; thence easterly along said center line 149 feet, more or less, to a point in the east line of Lot 11, Brookside extended south; thence north along said extension and lot line to the northeast corner of said Lot 11, being also a point in the center line of Johnson Creek; thence westerly along said center line and north lot line to the point of beginning.

EXHIBIT "B"

ORDINANCE No. 149397

An Ordinance fixing a public hearing for May 7, 1980, at 9:30 a.m., in the Council Chamber of the City Hall, on the question of withdrawal from Gilbert Water District of Lot 1, Brookside, and Lot 11, Brookside, annexed to the City of Portland, authorizing the City Auditor to publish and post notices and expend money therefor, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Lot 1, Brookside and Lot 11, Brookside, has been annexed to the City by Portland Metropolitan Area Local Government Boundary Commission Final Order No. 1494, effective October 25, 1979 and Final Order No. 1448, effective August 30, 1979.
2. It is appropriate to withdraw said area from Gilbert Water District pursuant to ORS 199.510(b), 222.520 and 222.524.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. A public hearing shall be held on May 7, 1980, at 9:30 a.m., in the Council Chamber of the City Hall, at which time objections shall be heard regarding withdrawal from said district of the property described in Exhibit "A" and Exhibit "B".
- b. The City Auditor is authorized to publish notice of the date, time, place and purpose of said hearing once each week for two successive weeks prior to the hearing in the City official newspaper, and shall cause notices of said hearing to be posted in four public places in the City for a like period.
- c. The City Auditor is authorized to expend money for such publication as may be needed, chargeable to the appropriation for such advertising.
- d. The City Auditor shall notify said district of said hearing.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the hearing must be held without undue delay on the question of withdrawal of said property from said district; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
