AMENDING AGREEMENT

An agreement to amend Contract No. 17654 between Carson, Bekooy, Gulick and Associates, (hereinafter called the Engineer) and the City of Portland (hereinafter called the City).

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the parties entered into an agreement, Contract No. 17654 on January 10, 1979 for engineering consultant services related to the implementation of the City's Energy Conservation Program.

WHEREAS, Contract No. 17654 provided for completion of all tasks specified in the contract by December 31, 1979.

WHEREAS, circumstances beyond the control of the engineer such as City staff turnover and delays imposed by external agencies have made it impossible to meet this deadline.

WHEREAS, by extending the deadline to October 1, 1980, the City will receive a more complete, comprehensive energy engineering program including; training programs, operating personnel Training Seminars, developing and distributing operating Building Maintenance Manuals and implementation of the City Facility Energy Retrofit Program.

WHEREAS, the contractor's rate schedule has increased as of January 1, 1980.

WHEREAS, all other terms and conditions of the contract will remain unchanged.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, the parties hereto do agree as follows:

Contract No. 17654 is amended as follows:

1. The completion date (Item III, paragraph C), shall not exceed October 1, 1980.

2. The Engineer's hourly rates (Item IV, paragraph a) are amended as follows:

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ORDINANCE NO. 149402

An Ordinance authorizing an amendment to Contract No. 17654 with Carson, Bekooy, Gulick and Associates, Inc., Consulting Engineers by extending the completion time of the contract, modifying compensation rates at no additional cost to the City, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- That on January 10, 1979, the City entered into Contract No. 17654 with the firm of Carson, Bekooy, Gulick and Associates, Inc. for consulting services in relation to the implementation of the City's Energy Conservation Program.
- 2. That, under the terms of this contract, the consultant is to review energy retrofit options, prepare operating guidelines, develop training sessions for City personnel, and participate in the development of an automated accounting system to track the consumption of energy in City facilities.
- 3. That the review of energy retrofit options was complicated by the fact that much of the data gathered through the City's preliminary energy audit required professional mechanical engineering interpretation. This professional engineering service will maximize the benefits received from the implementation of the 1979-80 energy retrofit projects.
- 4. That the consultant's participation in the development of an automated accounting system is part of a team effort which includes representatives from the utilities, the Data Processing Authority, and City staff. Because of scheduling conflicts beyond the consultant's control, this element of the contract is behind schedule.
- 5. That Contract No. 17654 provided completion of all tasks by December 31, 1979.
- 6. That on December 31, 1979, it was not possible to project the revised completion date. It is now possible to project the completion date of October 1, 1980.
