



ORDINANCE NO. 149407

An Ordinance amending Contract No. 17921 with William Hoffstetter to increase the fee schedule and increase by \$15,000 the maximum fee for the provision of geological consulting services for the Groundwater Development Program, Bureau of Water Works, providing for acceptance, authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants, transferring funds, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City has entered into Contract No. 17921 with William Hoffstetter to provide geological consulting services to monitor the construction of production wells for the Water Bureau's Groundwater Development Program.
2. The City, by Ordinance 148046, increased by 50% the number of production wells to be drilled under Contract No. 17890 for the construction of the wells which are to be monitored under Contract No. 17921.
3. Contract No. 17921 permits renegotiation of the consultant's fee schedule if the consultant services are required after April 2, 1980, and the consultant has requested that the fee schedule be renegotiated.
4. The additional geological consulting services required for the Groundwater Development Program necessitate that the maximum fee allowed under Contract No. 17921 be increased by \$15,000 to a maximum of \$40,000.
5. It is necessary to transfer \$15,000 within the Water Fund between Object Codes.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Article 2 of Contract No. 17921 is amended to read as follows:

"ARTICLE 2. Payment as Consideration for Providing the Services Enumerated in Article 1. The OWNER shall pay the GEOLOGIST monthly for work performed during the preceding month, and upon its acceptance by the OWNER's Commissioner of Public Utilities, a sum equal to direct salary costs at the rate of \$15.40 for each hour that the GEOLOGIST's services are required by the OWNER. Automobile travel required to accomplish the work shall be billed as

an expense at the rate of 25 cents per mile. All other expenses of the GEOLOGIST shall have prior approval of the OWNER and be billed at the actual cost to the GEOLOGIST.

Based on the scope of services outlined herein, the total fee for the services shall not exceed \$40,000 unless authorized in writing by the OWNER."

- b. Article 4 of Contract No. 17921 is amended by the addition of the following to the first paragraph:

"Such new schedule of compensation shall contain a percentage increase in fees over the previously established fees no greater than the percentage increase in the Federal Government's Consumer Price Index for the Portland, Oregon, area computed over the period of time elapsed after the date that the previous fees were established."


- c. The amendment to Contract No. 17921 will not be effective until written notice of acceptance of the Ordinance by William Hoffstetter is filed with the City Auditor.
- d. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the 1979-80 Budget, Water Fund, BUC 18600374, Project 3700, Object Code 210, when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.
- e. Fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) is transferred within the Water Fund, BUC 18600374, Project 3700, from Object Code 630 (Improvements) to Object Code 210 (Professional Services).


Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in amending the contract will unnecessarily deprive the City of the benefits that would be derived from the service provided by the contract; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
