

ORDINANCE No. 149414

An Ordinance transferring \$5,100 within the General Fund from General Operating Contingency to the Bureau of Street and Structural Engineering for reprinting the Portland Bicycle Map, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Portland Bicycle Map was published in an edition of 5,000 copies in July 1979, paid for by the 1% Gas Tax. Reprinting will be necessary in the summer of 1980, and funds for this purpose are included in the proposed F.Y. 1980-81 Budget.
2. Appleton Paper Co., suppliers of the waterproof stock used for the map, has placed an order for 7,000 copies of the map with Durham and Downey, printers of the first edition. Appleton will use these maps for paper samples.
3. Durham and Downey has estimated that costs to the City for updating and reprinting 5,000 copies of the map would be about \$5,100 if the City order is run with the Appleton order. Cost of reprinting after July 1, as is presently scheduled, would be an additional \$900.
4. Expenditures from the General Fund for reprinting the map will be recovered from map sales revenues. Sales of the first edition have thus far generated \$3,100 in revenue.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That \$5,100 be transferred within the General Fund from General Operating Contingency to the Bureau of Street and Structural Engineering (15900351/3378/260) for reprinting the Portland Bicycle Map.


Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because the transfer and appropriation are needed for reprinting of the map to be scheduled to coincide with the order by Appleton Paper Co.; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
