An Ordinance authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants, in various amounts, in settlement of eleven claims which have been investigated by the Committee on Claims and approved by the City Council, providing for release, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:
