

ORDINANCE No. 149443

An Ordinance transferring \$2,500 within the General Operating Contingency to the Bureau of Emergency Communications (AU 620) Office of Emergency Services (RU 622), and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Council authorized an application to the Defense Civil Preparedness Administration (DCPA) for a grant estimated at \$110,714 in aid of the identification of hazardous materials risk in the City of Portland and to prepare a plan to respond to hazardous materials incidents.
2. The Federal Emergency Management Agency (formerly DCPA) has agreed to fund \$40,000 of said grant for research and development projects.
3. To acquire the funds, a revised scope of work and workplan must be submitted to that agency.
4. A part-time staff assistant is now required in order to research and develop that workplan. This position is time limited and has established performance objectives and indicators.
5. The funds required for this project should be transferred from General Operating Contingency to the Bureau of Emergency Communications Office of Emergency Services.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Appropriation authority within the General Fund is transferred as follows:

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the appropriation is needed immediately in the account to which it is to be transferred so that there may be no program interruption or administrative delay; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
