## ORDINANCE No. 149443

An Ordinance transferring \$2,500 within the General Operating Contingency to the Bureau of Emergency Communications (AU 620) Office of Emergency Services (RU 622), and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Council authorized an application to the Defense Civil Preparedness Administration (DCPA) for a grant estimated at \$110,714 in aid of the identification of hazardous materials risk in the City of Portland and to prepare a plan to respond to hazardous materials incidents.
- 2. The Federal Emergency Management Agency (formerly DCPA) has agreed to fund \$40,000 of said grant for research and development projects.
- 3. To acquire the funds, a revised scope of work and workplan must be submitted to that agency.
- 4. A part-time staff assistant is now required in order to research and develop that workplan. This position is time limited and has established performance objectives and indicators.
- 5. The funds required for this project should be transferred from General Operating Contingency to the Bureau of Emergency Communications Office of Emergency Services.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:
