ORDINANCE NO. 149446

An Ordinance authorizing application by the Bureau of Parks to the Oregon State Marine Board for a grant estimated at \$10,000 for redesign and engineering of the existing boatramp at Willamette Park, authorizing a contract and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Oregon State Marine Board makes grants to local governments for the construction and maintenance of boating facilities and related projects.
- 2. The boatramp at Willamette Park has deteriorated to an unsafe condition due to erosion of its underwater portion.
- 3. The grant application will request funds for Phase I of the project in the amount of \$10,000 for redesign and engineering of the boatramp. Full indirect costs at a rate of 17 percent are included in the grant budget. No local match is required.
- 4. Upon completion of Phase I, a Phase II application will be submitted to the State Marine Board for a grant to construct the new boatramp.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Park Bureau Planning and Development Manager shall make application to the Oregon State Marine Board for a grant estimated at \$10,000 for design and engineering of a boatramp at Willamette Park.
- b. Should the described grant be approved, a contract or grant agreement is authorized.
- c. The Commissioner in charge is authorized to provide assurances regarding the use of the grant as may be required by the Oregon State Marine Board.

- d. The Commissioner in charge is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for receipt, expenditure and accounting for the grant project.
- e. Expenditures under this grant are not authorized until the Oregon State Marine Board has approved the grant, the Council has specifically appropriated the funds; and the system of accountability has been established by the Bureau of Financial Affairs.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because there is a grant application deadline and delay in applying may result in the loss of opportunity to receive the grant; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
