

**ORDINANCE No. 149418**

An Ordinance authorizing the transfer of \$2,000 within the General Fund from Operating Contingency to the Bureau of Police to provide for the payment of an Officer's funeral expenses and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. That Section 55 of the contracted labor agreement between the City of Portland and the Portland Police Association provides: In the event an officer is killed in the line of duty, or dies from injuries sustained in the line of duty, the City shall pay the sum of \$2,000 toward funeral and connected expenses to his surviving spouse (or, if none, to his heirs), regardless of amounts paid from other sources.
2. That the life of Officer David W. Crowther ceased on December 27, 1979 due to injuries sustained in the line of duty.
3. That resources for this obligation by the City were not provided in the Police Bureau's FY 1979-80 budget due to its uncommon occurrence.
4. That additional appropriations necessary to pay the above should be provided by transfer from Operating Contingency to the Bureau of Police.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:


- a. That appropriations of \$2,000 be transferred within the General Fund from Operating Contingency (20100010) to the Bureau of Police (10200016.260, Project 0900).


Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because it is necessary that the appropriation transfer herein described should not be unnecessarily delayed; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
