

**ORDINANCE No. 149489**

An Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent to call for bids to construct Five Cathodic Protection Stations, Conduit Corrosion Control, Phase IV, for corrosion protection of the Bull Run Conduits for the Bureau of Water Works, authorizing a contract therefore, authorizing the drawing and delivery of a warrant(s), and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Water Works has need for the construction of Five Cathodic Protection Stations, which installations are an important factor for Phase IV for corrosion protection of the Bull Run conduits.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Purchasing Agent shall advertise for bids using specifications filed in his office on **APR 17 1980** and in the event that no satisfactory bid is received, shall readvertise on the same basic specifications until a satisfactory bid is received.
- b. A contract is authorized with the most favorable bidder as designated by the Council.
- c. The Mayor and the Auditor hereby are authorized to draw and deliver a warrant(s) chargeable to the 1979-80 Budget, Bureau of Water Works, Water Fund, Object Code 633, Project No. 3705, BUC 18600374, when demand is presented, approved by the proper authorities.


Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with the project may result in additional expense, and will unnecessarily deprive the City of the benefits of completion of the contract at an early date; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
