
ORDINANCE NO. 149512

- An Ordinance authorizing an application to the Federal Highway Administration for a grant estimated at \$43,989 in aid of bicycle programs, and declaring an emergency.
- The City of Portland ordains:
- Section 1. The Council finds:
 - 1. The Federal Highway Administration makes grants to local governments in aid of bicycle programs.
 - 2. The Bicycle and Pedestrian Program provides a full range of activities to promote bicycling and could further the City's effort therein by a grant in aid of said services.
 - 3. The project cost is estimated at \$58,652 of which \$14,663 is required as local share, which local share is available to the Bicycle and Pedestrian Program from the 1% Gas Tax revenues.
 - 4. Should the City receive the grant, it will be obligated to comply with the regulations of the Federal Highway Administration.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and Commissioner in charge shall make application to the Federal Highway Administration for a grant of \$43,989 in aid of providing additional bicycle parking downtown and providing a management grant to the Bicycle Commuter Service.
- b. Should the described grant be approved, a contract or grant agreement is authorized.
- c. The Commissioner in charge is authorized to provide assurances regarding the use of the grant as may be required by the Federal Highway Administration.
- d. The Commissioner in charge is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for receipt, expenditure, and accounting for the grant project.
- e. Expenditures under this grant are not authorized until Federal Highway Administration has approved the grant; the Council has specifically appropriated the funds; and the system of accountability has been established by the Bureau of Financial Affairs.
