Cody,

Thank you for forwarding the complaint. On May 18<sup>th</sup> it was brought to our attention that the campaign had reported income in excess of the amount allowed by participants of the Open and Accountable Election program. At the time we did not realized that in-kind donations counted towards the \$250,000 limits. The OAE candidate guide does not specifically indicate that in-kinds are included in the total limits, only that campaigns are limited to a \$20,000 total of in-kinds support.

Upon closer review of the regulations, we acknowledge the oversight. We then worked with OAE officials to correct the mistake. Attached is our correspondence with OAE outlining the course of correction. In order to remain compliant the committee through my firm returned funds to the city in the amount of \$15,191, which has been reported as a Personal Expenditure on behalf of the Mapps campaign.
