

ORDINANCE No. 190271

* Accept and appropriate a grant in the amount of \$75,000 from Metro for the Unite East Portland Project, authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement, and authorize the Director of the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability to execute a grant agreement in the amount of \$75,000 with Unite Oregon (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Metro has notified the City of Portland that it has been awarded a 2040 Planning and Development Grant for the Unite East Portland Project in the amount of \$75,000.
2. The project will provide a basis for an updated planning framework for East Portland that is informed and centered on the needs and aspirations of the area's communities of color, who are a large proportion of this area's population and have often not benefited from past City projects and investments.
3. The full grant amount of \$75,000 will be provided to the Center for Intercultural Organizing ("Unite Oregon") to lead the Unite East Portland Project's community engagement and to fund the participation of smaller community organizations, stipends for participants, and translation and interpretation services in order to ensure the project reaches as diverse a population as possible. Unite Oregon was a partner in the Metro grant application and was selected to lead the project's community engagement because of its experience in engaging and organizing people of color and immigrants.
4. The Portland Bureau of Planning and Sustainability ("BPS") will manage the project in consultation with City agencies that are participating in the East Portland Equitable Investments Bureau Advisory Group.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability Director ("BPS Director") is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from Metro in the amount of \$75,000 for the Unite East Portland Project and to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement substantially similar to Exhibit A.
- b. The BPS Director is hereby authorized to execute a grant agreement in a form substantially similar to Exhibit B to distribute the \$75,000 in grant funds to Unite Oregon.

- c. The FY2020/2021 budget is hereby amended as follows. The Portland Bureau of Planning and Sustainability will incorporate \$75,000 in grant revenue into District Planning budget and provide the full amount as a grant to United Oregon.

- d. BPS and the Office of Management & Finance Grants Division are authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required grant documents on the Director's behalf.
- e. The BPS Director is authorized to execute amendments to the Agreement, provided such modifications do not increase the City's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the City Council.
- f. The City Council waives the competitive application process required in FIN 2.04 – Budget. The Unite East Portland Project community engagement requires a community organization that has existing and deep relationships and understanding of communities of color and immigrants in East Portland. Unite Oregon is uniquely positioned to carry out this work.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
