ORDINANCE No. 190279

* Accept the FY 2018 Federal Emergency Management Agency Pre-Disaster Mitigation Grant in the amount of \$150,000 from the Oregon Department of Emergency Management to update the City's Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) provides hazard mitigation grant funding to reduce risk to local communities. The Pre-Disaster Mitigation (PDM) grant provides funding to update mitigation plans, such as Portland's Mitigation Action Plan.
- 2. FEMA requires an approved mitigation plan in order to be eligible for mitigation grant funding. The Oregon office of Emergency Management requires an approved mitigation plan in order to be eligible for Emergency Management Performance Grant funding. Portland's mitigation plan, maintained by the Portland Bureau of Emergency Management (PBEM), will expire in November 2021.
- 3. Local match in the amount of \$50,000 for the PDM grant will be provided in the form of budgeted FY 20-21 funds by PBEM.
- 4. Application to this program was authorized by Council Ordinance No. 189318 in December 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from FEMA awarded through the Oregon Office of Emergency Management, in the amount of \$150,000 and to execute the grant agreement.
- b. The FY 2020-2021 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Fund 217
Business Area – EM00
Bureau Program Expenses - \$150,000

c. The Office of Management and Finance Grants Management Division is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement of amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

- d. The Director of the PBEM is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modification by the Oregon Office of Emergency Management for the FY2018 PDM Grant, grant number EMS-2020-PC-0005, subaward number PDMC-PL-10-OR-2018-03, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must by authorized by Portland City Council.
- e. The Director of PBEM is authorized to execute related subrecipient grant awards, contracts, and amendments.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because any delay in acceptance may delay the plan update beyond the expiration of the current plan; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
