*Authorize grant agreement with the McKenzie River Gathering Foundation for the Disability Leadership grant program in amount \$112,752 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The impact of COVID-19 on the City's resources is unprecedented, unpredictable and long-lasting. Per Resolution No. 37487 adopted by City Council on May 20, 2020, the City's responses to COVID-19 will be accountable and responsive to achieving the City's equity and climate action goals.
- Resolution No. 37517 passed by City Council on November 18, 2020, adopts
 Citywide Disability Equity Goals and affirms the City of Portland's commitment
 to providing equitable opportunities and access to Portland's disability
 communities.
- 3. Reports for the 2017 & 2018 Disability program leadership cohorts, accepted by City Council on September 27, 2017 and June 20, 2018 respectively, uplifted community requests for further capacity building within disability communities, including in Disability and BIPOC-centered organizations.
- 4. A total of \$112,752 General Fund dollars is allocated in the Office of Community & Civic Life's FY 2020-21 adopted budget for these grants and administration as part of the Disability Program. The Disability Program issued an open Request for Proposals and selected 10 nonprofit organizations to receive grants of up to \$10,000 each as listed in Exhibit A.
- 5. The McKenzie River Gathering (MRG) Foundation will serve as the fiscal agent of these grants. The Office of Community & Civic Life and the MRG Foundation are partnering to ensure timely distribution of these grants to the selected awardees.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Director of the Office of Community & Civic Life is authorized to execute a grant agreement for a total amount not to exceed \$112,752 with McKenzie River Gathering Foundation. The Director is authorized to execute the grant agreement in a form similar to the grant agreement template attached as Exhibit B.
- b. The application of Portland City Code Chapters 5.33 (Goods and Services) and 5.68 (Professional, Technical and Expert Services) is waived with respect to the

grant agreement described in Section 1.a above.

c. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay the grant funds from the General Fund.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because it is in the public interest to get these funds out the door as quickly as possible; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
