ORDINANCE No. 190300

*Pay settlement of Martha Bleck bodily injury lawsuit in the sum of \$25,000 involving the Portland Bureau of Transportation (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Martha Bleck, through attorney Samuel Pope, has filed a lawsuit against the City for injuries suffered in a trip and fall incident involving the Portland Bureau of Transportation on April 25, 2019.
- 2. The lawsuit has been investigated by Risk Management Services. The investigation indicates there is risk the City may be found liable. Therefore, in order to avoid the risk of an adverse jury award, we feel it is prudent to compromise the lawsuit at this time.
- 3. Risk Management Services recommends the lawsuit be compromised for the total sum of \$25,000, subject to the claimant providing the City with a release in a form to be approved by the City Attorney.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a check in the amount of \$25,000 made payable to Rizk Law IOLTA.
- b. Risk Management Services will execute a payment authorization in the amount set forth in sub-paragraph (a) above.
