

ORDINANCE NO. 149834

An Ordinance authorizing a contract with Motorola Communications and Electronics, Inc., to furnish a closed circuit television system at Reservoir No. 6 to the Bureau of Electronic Services, transferring \$48,615.85 from the Water Fund to the Electronic Services Operating Fund, authorizing the drawing and delivery of a warrant/s and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Motorola Communications and Electronics, Inc., was the lowest responsible bidder for furnishing a closed circuit television system for surveillance at Reservoir No. 6 for the Bureau of Electronic Services.
2. Award of a contract to said bidder for furnishing the equipment has been recommended and approved by the Commissioner-in-Charge.
3. The necessary appropriation for the purchase of this equipment should be provided to the Bureau of Electronic Services by fund transfers from the Bureau of Water Works' Water Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Works and the Auditor hereby are authorized to execute a contract with Motorola Communications and Electronics, Inc., for the equipment described in Section 1 hereof, in accordance with specifications filed with the Purchasing Agent on May 21, 1980.
- b. The Mayor and the Auditor hereby are authorized to draw and deliver a warrant/s chargeable to the 1979-80 Electronic Services Budget (36000252.640), when demand is presented, approved by the proper authorities.
- c. Appropriation is increased in the Electronic Services Operating Fund by \$48,615.85 through transfer from the Water Fund as follows:
