

## ORDINANCE No. 149838

An Ordinance transferring appropriation within the Water Fund to cover extraordinary overtime expenditures and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Water Works was requested by the Department of Public Works to assist in the clearing of debris as a result of an unusual ice storm and washing volcanic ash from city streets.
2. The Bureau of Water Works responded to these requests and a significant portion of the work was performed on overtime status at a total overtime cost of \$10,964.
3. The above described work was unrelated to the operation and maintenance of the water system and not anticipated in the preparation of the 1979-80 budget.
4. As overtime is a controlled line item, the transfer is necessary to ensure that an over-expenditure does not occur.
5. There is sufficient appropriation in Personnel Services major object class to cover this expenditure.
6. The Bureau of Water Works is in need of additional overtime appropriation and the Commissioner in Charge recommends a transfer of \$10,964 from Full Time Employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. A transfer of appropriation, in the amount of \$10,964, be made within the Water Fund (number 05) from Construction and Maintenance, Field Support, Full Time Employees (BUC 18400081, Project 0184, Object 110) to Construction and Maintenance, Field Support, Overtime (BUC 18400081, Project 0184, Object 140).

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists as the necessary transfer of appropriation may be made without undue delay, therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


