

# ORDINANCE No. 149839

An Ordinance transferring \$5,690 within the General Operating Contingency to the Bureau of Emergency Communications (AU 620) Office of Emergency Services (RU 622) for the purpose of paying costs for masks needed during volcanic ash fall in May, 1980, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Emergency Communications, Office of Emergency Services, requires \$5,690 additional within its budget to pay costs incurred for emergency operations during the volcanic ash related emergency.
2. The Office of Emergency Services incurred \$5,690 in charges for the purchase of safety masks provided to City workers during the ash fall.
3. The additional appropriation should be provided by transfer from the General Operating Contingency to the Bureau of Emergency Communications (AU 620) Office of Emergency Services (RU 622).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:


- a. Appropriation authority within the General Fund is transferred as follows:

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists, because the appropriation is needed immediately in the account to which it is to be transferred so that there may be no program interruption or administrative delay; therefore; this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
