## ORDINANCE NO. 149840

An Ordinance authorizing the transfer of \$131,080 within the General Fund from General Operating Contingency to the Bureau of Maintenance to provide funds for extraordinary expenditures related to volcanic ash removal, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland Ordains:

#### Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Maintenance has incurred extraordinary expenses related to removal of volcanic ash.
- 2. In providing assistance to the City of Yakima, identified expenses were \$68,150.
- 3. Employees assigned to Yakima were provided ten dollars per day to cover miscellaneous expenses of being away from home.
- 4. Expenses incurred in assisting the City of Yakima are reimbursable through contractural agreement.
- 5. The emergency response to reduce ash in the City of Portland expenses were \$62,930.
- 6. Appropriations should be provided to fund these expenses from the General Fund Contingency.

#### NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The FY 1979-80 City Budget is hereby amended to change appropriations as follows:
