

## **ORDINANCE No. 190306**

\*Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the Outer Halsey Safety Project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. This portion of NE Halsey is on the High Crash Network and is in a high-equity-need area.
2. The project's scope includes sidewalk infill along NE Halsey from NE 114<sup>th</sup> to 162<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, a rapid flashing beacon and enhanced lighting at NE 119<sup>th</sup> and NE 128<sup>th</sup>, and ADA accessible curb ramp upgrades.
3. The project is identified in the City's Capital Improvement Program (CIP).
4. The Bureau of Transportation has funds budgeted in FY 2021 and proposed FY 2022 for construction, inspection and management of the project.
5. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimate for this project is moderate; project is well defined and plans and specifications are nearing completion. .

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to facilitate the competitive solicitation process in accordance with City Code 5.34 to obtain the lowest most responsible bidder.
- b. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to award, negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's Office.
- c. The Mayor or Auditor to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to T00663 when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the project must be bid as soon as possible to begin construction in summer 2021; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
