- NW Aspen Ave Existing Conditions
- Five properties with nonconforming sewers
- Permanent and temporary construction easements
- Dry-weather construction
- NW Thurman St Reconstruction Sewer Project



## Project Objectives

- Construct new combined sewer that connects to the existing public sewer on private property.



## Project Overview

## - Permanent Public Sewer

## Easements

- Provides property rights for the operation and maintenance of the sewer, as well as construction
- 2102 NW Aspen Ave and 2024 NW Aspen Ave
- Much of this area is covered by an existing easement for a public storm sewer and combined sewer



## Project Overview

## - Temporary Construction Easements

- Provides temporary property rights for the construction of the sewer
- 3454 NW Thurman St
- 2024 NW Aspen Ave



## Project Budget and Schedule

- Budget
- Easement costs will be largely dependent on appraisals and negotiations with property owners
- Schedule
- Easements anticipated to be in place by summer for dry-weather construction


## Closing

- Approval of this ordinance gives PBOT the authority to compensate affected property owners for the needed permanent and temporary easements for E10953 NW Aspen Ave Combined Sewer Extension project
- All affected property owners have been informed of the project need for these property rights and were invited to attend this reading.
