

## ORDINANCE No. 149867

An Ordinance transferring appropriations within the General Fund from the Bureau of Police, Criminalistics Division, to Operating Contingency, transferring appropriations between object classes within the Police Bureau's FY 80-81 operating budget and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. That pursuant to Ordinance No. 149684, the Bureau of Police, Criminalistics Division, began a modified procedure for identification processing at the Multnomah County booking facility.
2. That the results of the said procedure modification will generate savings in the amount of \$10,016 in the Bureau of Police during FY 80-81.
3. That since this procedure was commenced after the City's and the Police Bureau's FY 80-81 budget was approved, it is therefore, necessary to transfer the identified savings to Operating Contingency and to adjust the Police Bureau's operating budget for FY 80-81.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:


- a. That appropriations be transferred, effective July 1, 1980, within the General Fund and within the Police Bureau's FY 80-81 operating budget as follows:
