# ORDINANCE No. 149868

An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 149689 to allow warrants to be charged against the 1980-81 budget for the Bureau of Fleet Management, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

### Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Fleet Management requested and the Council directed in Ordinance 149689, passed June 4, 1980, the Purchasing Agent to advertise for bids for a Vacuum Type Street Sweeper.
- 2. The ordinance authorized the drawing of warrants chargeable to the 1979-80 budget for this purchase.
- 3. Because of the timing of this authorization, it was not possible to complete the bid process and the contract in time to encumber these funds during FY 1979-80. The Bureau of Fleet Management now requests that this purchase be made as a part of the FY 1980-81 budget.
- 4. The Commissioner of Public Utilities and the Purchasing Agent concur with this request.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That section 1. paragraph c. of ordinance 149689 be amended to authorize the drawing and delivery of warrants chargeable to the 1980-81 Budget, Fleet Operating Fund.
- b. All other wording and conditions of ordinance 149689 shall remain unchanged and in full force.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with the purchase may result in additional expenses, and will unnecessarily deprive the City of the benefits of completion of the contract at an early date; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
