ORDINANCE NO. 149886

An Ordinance creating one position of Public Safety Analyst in the Bureau of Fire (AU 124) effective July 1, 1980 and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- That Council authorized creating a new position referred to as a Fire Information Systems Manager in lieu of an existing Public Safety Analyst position within the FY 1980-81 Budget for the purpose of supervising the Prevention Building Inspections Computer System and developing a bureau wide comprehensive management information system.
- That effective April 8, 1980 the Bureau of Fire terminated development of the Prevention Division Building Information System thereby decreasing the need for the aforementioned Fire Information Systems Manager.
- 3. That the Bureau of Fire requires the continuation of an existing Public Safety Analyst for on-going data collection and to conduct special studies of a statistical nature. The position should, therefore, be recreated in lieu of the Fire Information Systems Manager within the FY 1980-81 Budget.
- 4. That the Bureau of Fire will continue in its pursuit of a comprehensive management information system through staff research projects and as appropriate consultant services.
- 5. That the proposed classification of Fire Information Systems Manager has not been created by the Civil Service Board.
- 6. That this action will decrease bureau FY 1980-81 Personal Services requirements by approximately \$3,299 in salary.
- 7. That the Bureau of Personnel Services has reviewed and concurs with this action.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The position of Public Safety Analyst is created in the Bureau of Fire (AU 124) with a salary rate conforming to the current compensation plan effective July 1, 1980.

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- b. The position referred to as the Fire Information Systems Manager within the FY 1980-81 Bureau of Fire approved budget is abolished effective July 1, 1980.
- Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the position being created is required in order that the functions of the Bureau of Fire may be carried out without delay; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
