

ORDINANCE NO. 149894

An Ordinance granting a revocable permit to David G. and Sharin M. Meier to maintain a portion of their residence in the street area of S.W. 10th Avenue south of S.W. Chestnut Street and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. David G. and Sharin M. Meier, owners of the property at 940 S.W. Chestnut Street, Portland, Oregon 97219, applied for a building permit (Application No. 2546) to remodel their residence and that survey required for the plot plan required for a building permit shows that their residence extends into the right-of-way area.
- 2. David G. and Sharin M. Meier have requested permission to maintain their residence as located and shown on the attached "Exhibit A".
- 3. The granting of said permission will not be detrimental to the public under certain conditions.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. A revocable permit is granted to David G. and Sharin M. Meier to maintain their residence as it encroaches into the right of way of S.W. 10th Avenue adjacent to Tax Lot 1, of Lots 11, 12, and 13, Block 32, Burlingame Addition and located as shown on the "Exhibit A" attached to and by this reference made a part of this Ordinance subject to the following conditions:
 - (1) This permit is for the use of the street area only, and shall not exempt the permittee from obtaining any license or permit required by the City Code or Ordinances for any act to be performed under this permit, nor shall this permit waive the provisions of any City Code, Ordinance, or the City Charter.
 - (2) The permit is revocable at any time at the pleasure of the Council, and no expenditure of money hereunder or lapse of time or other act or thing shall operate as an estoppel against the City of Portland or be held to give the permittee any vested or other right. Upon revocation of this permit by the Council the permittee shall within 90 days remove that portion of their residence which extends into the street area as directed by the City Engineer.

- (3) This permit is a burden upon the property and runs with the land and will require insurance with limits of coverage that will meet the maximum requirements for liability of a public body as set forth in ORS 30.270 or as it may require by subsequent amendment and naming the City of Portland, its officers, agents, and employees as additional insureds.
- (4) The permittee shall hold the City of Portland, its officers, agents, and employees free and harmless from any claims for damages to persons or property, including legal fees and costs of defending any actions or suits, including any appeals which may result from the use of the street area under this permit by providing evidence of insurance protecting the City of Portland, its officers, agents, and employees as follows:

 Bodily injury \$100,000 for one claimant and \$300,000 for one occurrence, property damage \$50,000 for one claimant and \$300,000 for one occurrence, said insurance to be kept in full force and effect at all times. This permit is automatically revoked without further action by the Council if this insurance is permitted to lapse, is cancelled or, for any other reason, becomes inoperative.
- (5) The permittee shall pay the permit fee of \$10.00 required by Section 17.24.020 of the City Code.
- (6) The permittee shall reimburse the City for the cost of filing by the City Auditor of a certified copy of this Ordinance with the Records Division of Multnomah County.
- Section 2. This Ordinance will not become effective until the grantee has filed with the City Auditor both a document accepting the terms and conditions hereof, and the evidence of insurance, each of which has been approved by the City Attorney.
- Section 3. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in the enactment of this Ordinance will result in an unnecessary hardship on the part of the applicants as to the status of the requested permit; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
