Legislation title: Accept recommendation of the Central Eastside Industrial Council and approve the removal of the 2.3 percent annual escalator amount for Central Eastside Together Enhanced Service District license fees for one year to begin July 1, 2021 (Resolution)

Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The annual license fee paid by property managers in the Central Eastside Together ESD includes an automatic 2.3% annual escalation, which would be effective for the license year beginning July 1, 2021. City Code Section 6.06.360 includes provisions to reduce the 2.3% escalator for a particular license year. The Central Eastside Industrial Council Board of Directors approved the removal of this escalator for the upcoming license year due to the economic impact that the COVID-19 pandemic has had on the district. The requirements of Code Section 6.06.360 have been met, other than City Council approval.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

There is no financial impact to the City of Portland. The removal of the escalator is not expected to result in a significant decrease in services that the ESD provides. It is not expected to impact contract service levels or contract employee wages.

Community impacts and community involvement:

This legislation is not expected to have any community impacts and therefore does not warrant any specific community involvement.
